

Service Learning Curriculum Integration Models

Option A

The *Traditional Option* features two equally weighted papers and three equally weighted exams. The *Service Learning Option* gives students credit for their service learning hours and related assignments. In addition, the same three exams used in the *Traditional Option* are given to the service learning students but count as quizzes with reduced point totals. The service learning option is a great opportunity for students who experience test anxiety to be successful in a course.
